

## **Twinning Light Project with United Kingdom**

In 2006 the IAID had embarked on a twinning light project financed from the EU Transition Facility Funds 2004 in conjunction with the United Kingdom. The objective of this project was to assist the IAID officers in gaining expertise in managing and disseminating information that would be available to the Division in view of its responsibilities, particularly those emanating from EU Regulations.

In this regard the UK National Audit Office (UK NAO) worked with the IAID to:

Enhance IAID's auditors knowledge of the audit requirements relevant to EU Structural Funds and how those audit requirements may be met;

Enhance IAID's auditors expertise in conducting investigations of irregularities and with regard to the irregularity reporting requirements relevant to EU Structural Funds; and

Assess the IAID's information needs to meet the above requirements and their existing IT systems and make recommendations to improve efficiency and develop a strategy for meeting future IT needs.

Between the months of March and July 2007, several experts from the UK came to the IAID offices to deliver these training sessions.
